An Act to amend the Criminal Law Consolidation Act, 1935, and to make a consequential amendment to the Trustee Act, 1936.

[Assented to 24 May 1984]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short title.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Criminal Law Consolidation Act Amendment Act, 1984".
- (2) The Criminal Law Consolidation Act, 1935, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

Amendment of s. 3—
Arrangement of

2. Section 3 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the item: PART X—Prisoners' Property (Sections 329-346).

Repeal of s. 296.

- 3. Section 296 of the principal Act is repealed.
- Insertion of new s. 329.
- 4. The following section is inserted in Part IX after section 328a of the principal Act:

Provision as to persons convicted of treason or a felony. 329. A person who has been convicted of treason, a felony or any other offence shall not, by reason of that conviction, suffer any legal disability except such as is prescribed by an Act of the State or the Commonwealth.

Repeal of Part X.

5. Part X of the principal Act is repealed.

Amendment of s. 88 of the Trustee Act, 1936. 6. Section 88 of the Trustee Act, 1936, is repealed.
