An Act to amend the Criminal Law Consolidation Act 1935.

[Assented to 31 October 1991]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Short title

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Criminal Law Consolidation (Abolition of Year-and-a-day Rule) Amendment Act 1991*.

(2) The *Criminal Law Consolidation Act 1935* is referred to in this Act as "the principal Act".

Insertion of s. 18

2. The following section is inserted after section 17 of the principal Act:

Abolition of year-and-a-day rule

18. An act or omission that in fact causes death will be regarded in law as the cause of death even though the death occurs more than a year and a day after the act or omission.
