An Act to amend the Dentists Act, 1984.

[Assented to 26 October 1989]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Short title

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Dentists Act Amendment Act, 1989.
- (2) The Dentists Act, 1984, is referred to in this Act as "the principal Act".

Restriction of provision of dental treatment by unqualified persons

- 2. Section 38 of the principal Act is amended—
 - (a) by striking out from subsection (1) "No person may recover a fee or other charge for dental treatment provided by him" and substituting "A person must not provide dental treatment for fee or reward";

and

(b) by inserting at the end of subsection (1) "Penalty: Five thousand dollars or imprisonment for six months.".
