An Act to amend the Debt Adjustment Act, 1929.

[Assented to, November 20th, 1930.]

DE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Debt Adjustment Act short title. Amendment Act, 1930".
- (2) The Debt Adjustment Act, 1929 (which is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act"), and this Act may be cited together as the "Debt Adjustment Acts, 1929 and 1930".
- 2. This Act is incorporated with the Debt Adjustment Act, 1929, Incorporation. and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.
- 3. The Debt Adjustment Act, 1929, shall be construed as though Amendment of 1939, at the time of the passing of the said Act the following section had been included therein namely:—
 - 3A. Notwithstanding the provisions of The Real Property Application of Act. Act, 1886, this Act shall apply in relation to land which is subject to the provisions of that Act as well as in relation to other land.
 - 4. Section 8 of the principal Act is amended—

Amendment of principal Act, s. 8—Application.

(a) by striking out the words "On publication of the notice in Application. the Gazette" in the first line of subsection (4) thereof, and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "On the issue of a certificate by the Director as aforesaid"; and

(b) by

Debt Adjustment Act Amendment Act.—1930.

(b) by striking out the word "notice' in the said subsection wherever occurring, and by inserting in lieu thereof in every case the word "certificate".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 10—
Limitation of Act.

- 5. Section 10 of the principal Act is amended—
 - (a) by striking out the word "thirty-one" in the sixth line thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof the word "thirty-two"; and
 - (b) by striking out the word "thirty-two" in the last line thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof the word "thirty-three".
