An Act to declare and extend the Period of Operation of the Dried Fruits Acts, 1924 and 1925, and to validate certain acts, matters, and things purporting to have been done under the said Acts.

[Assented to, June 10th, 1927.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Dried Fruits Acts (Continuance) Act, 1927."

Short title and
incorporation.

(2) The Dried Fruits Acts, 1924 and 1925, and this Act may be cited together as the "Dried Fruits Acts, 1924 to 1927."

(3) This Act is incorporated with the Dried Fruits Acts, 1924 and 1925, and those Acts and this Act shall be read as one Act.

2. Notwithstanding section 2 of the Dried Fruits Act, 1924, the Dried Fruits Acts, 1924 and 1925, shall be deemed to have remained and to remain in operation continuously from the respective dates of the commencement of those Acts, until the thirty-first day of March, nineteen hundred and thirty.

3. No act, matter, or thing done by the Minister, the Board, or any other body or person, for the purpose of or in connection with the administration of the said Dried Fruits Acts, 1924 and 1925, or purporting to be so done, between the thirty-first day of March, nineteen

nineteen hundred and twenty-seven and the date of the commencement of this Act shall be deemed invalid on the ground that the said Acts were not in operation throughout that period or any part thereof.

Repeal of Act 1759
of 1926.

4. The Dried Fruits (Continuation of Operation) Act, 1926, is hereby repealed.
