An Act to amend the Dairy Industry Act, 1928.

[Assented to 15th December, 1937.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Dairy Industry Act Amendment Act, 1937". Short titles.

(2) The Dairy Industry Act, 1928-1935, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Dairy Industry Act, 1928-1937".

2. This Act is incorporated with the Dairy Industry Act, 1928-1935, and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.

3. Section 4 of the Dairy Industry Act, 1928-1935, is amended by striking out the words "or where milk is pasteurised or chilled" in the last line of the definition of "Factory". Amendment of Dairy Industry Act, 1928, s. 4— Interpretation of factory.
