An Act to legalize the marriage of a Man with the Sister of his deceased Wife.

[Reserved, 17th October, 1860.]

THEREAS doubts have arisen as to the validity in the Province Preamble. of South Australia of the marriage of a man with the sister of his deceased wife, and it is expedient to remove such doubts: Be it therefore Enacted, by the Governor-in-Chief of the Province of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly of the said Province, in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:

1. All marriages which have been heretofore, or which shall be Marriages with hereafter duly solemnized, within the said Province, between any deceased wife's sister valid. person and his deceased wife's sister, shall be deemed, and are hereby declared valid, and of full force and effect, any law or custom to the contrary notwithstanding
