An Act to amend the Evidence Act. 1929-1945.

[Assented to 2nd October, 1947.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South. Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Evidence Act Amend. Short titles. ment Act, 1947".
- (2) The Evidence Act, 1929-1945, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Evidence Act, 1929-1947".
- (3) The Evidence Act, 1929-1945, is hereinafter called "the principal Act".
- 2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Incorporation. Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.
- 3. Section 66 of the principal Act is amended by inserting Amendment of after the word "British" in the seventh line of subsection (1) principal Act—principal Act—principal Act the words "or Australian".
