An Act to amend the Evidence Act, 1929-1945.

[Assented to 2nd October, 1947.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Evidence Act Amendment Act, 1947". Short titles.

(2) The Evidence Act, 1929-1945, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Evidence Act, 1929-1947".

(3) The Evidence Act, 1929-1945, is hereinafter called "the principal Act".

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.

3. Section 66 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after the word "British" in the seventh line of subsection (1) the words "or Australian". Amendment of s. 66 of the principal Act—
Taking of affidavits outside of the State.
