An Act to further amend the Early Closing Acts, 1911 to 1924.

[*Assented to, December 24th, 1924.*]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited alone as the "Early Closing Short title.
(Renmark) Act, 1924."

(2) The Early Closing Acts, 1911 to 1924, and this Act may be cited together as the "Early Closing Acts, 1911 to 1924."

2. This Act is incorporated with the other Acts mentioned in section 1 of this Act, and those Acts and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.

3. For the purpose of Part II. of the Early Closing Act, 1911 (as amended by any subsequent Acts), any district constituted by or under the Renmark Irrigation Trusts Act, 1893, and the Acts amending that Act, shall be deemed to be a district council district, and may be constituted a Shopping District under the first-mentioned Act, notwithstanding that it is less than thirty-six square miles in area. Power to constitute Shopping Districts in irrigation districts.
