An Act to amend the Egg Industry Stabilization Act, 1973.

[Assented to 24 May 1984]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Egg Industry Stabilization Act Amendment Act, 1984". Short title.

(2) The Egg Industry Stabilization Act, 1973, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

2. Section 4 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out from the definition of "hen" the passage "six months" and substituting the passage "twenty-two weeks";

and

(b) by striking out from the definition of "pullet" the passage "six months" and substituting the passage "twenty-two weeks".

3. Section 5 of the principal Act is amended by striking out subsections (1) and (2) and substituting the following subsection:

s. 5—  
Application.

(1) This Act does not apply except in relation to a person who owns or keeps more than twenty hens for commercial purposes.
