An Act to amend the Egg Industry Stabilization Act, 1973.

[Assented to 24 May 1984]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Egg Industry Stabilization Act Short title. Amendment Act, 1984".
- (2) The Egg Industry Stabilization Act, 1973, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".
 - 2. Section 4 of the principal Act is amended—

Amendment of

(a) by striking out from the definition of "hen" the passage "six Interpretation. months" and substituting the passage "twenty-two weeks";

and

- (b) by striking out from the definition of "pullet" the passage "six months" and substituting the passage "twenty-two weeks".
- 3. Section 5 of the principal Act is amended by striking out subsections Amendment of (1) and (2) and substituting the following subsection:

Application.

(1) This Act does not apply except in relation to a person who owns or keeps more than twenty hens for commercial purposes.
