An Act to amend the Fences Act, 1975.

[Assented to 29 November 1990]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Short title

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Fences Act Amendment Act, 1990*.
- (2) The *Fences Act, 1975*, is referred to in this Act as “the principal Act”.

Commencement

- 2. This Act will come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

Insertion of new s. 12a

- 3. The following section is inserted after section 12 of the principal Act:

Variation of cost of work on appeal

12a. On an appeal against a determination or order of the court, the court hearing the appeal may, in addition to any other order it may make, vary any determination as to the cost of fencing work to take account of any variation in the cost subsequent to the determination.

Substitution of s. 13

- 4. Section 13 of the principal Act is revoked and the following section is substituted:

Jurisdiction of Court

13. (1) A local court of full jurisdiction has jurisdiction to hear and determine proceedings under this Act that involve a monetary claim for an amount exceeding the jurisdictional limit of local courts of limited jurisdiction.

(2) A local court of limited jurisdiction has jurisdiction to hear and determine any other proceedings under this Act.
