An Act to amend the Homes Act, 1941-1962.

[Assented to 3rd October, 1968.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Homes Act Amendment Act, 1968".

(2) The Homes Act, 1941-1962, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Homes Act, 1941-1968".

(3) The Homes Act, 1941-1962, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act."

Amendment of

2. Subsection (2) of section 7 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the passage "three thousand five hundred pounds" in paragraph III and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "eight thousand dollars".

3. The principal Act is amended by striking out each passage therein (except any passage amended by this Act) representing an amount of money in terms of the currency provided for by the *Coinage Act* 1909-1947 of the Commonwealth and inserting in lieu thereof in each case a passage representing the equivalent amount of money in terms of the currency provided for by the *Currency Act* 1965 of the Commonwealth calculated on the basis of the equivalents specified in subsection (4) of section 8 of that Act.
