An Act to amend the Homes Act, 1941-1952.

[Assented to 1st November, 1956.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Homes Act Amendment Act, 1956". Short titles.

(2) The Homes Act, 1941-1952, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Homes Act, 1941-1956".

(3) The Homes Act, 1941-1952, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. Section 7 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out the word "five" in the third line of paragraph (b) thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof the word "six" ;

(b) by striking out the word "five" in the fifth line of paragraph (b) thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof the word "six".
