An Act to amend the Highways Act, 1926-1936.

[Assented to 27th October, 1937.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short title.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Highways Act Amendment Act, 1937".
- (2) The Highways Act, 1926-1936, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Highways Act, 1926-1937".
- (3) The Highways Act, 1926-1936 is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Incorporation.

2. This Act is incorporated with the Highways Act, 1926-1936, and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

Commencement of Act.

3. This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of July, nineteen hundred and thirty-seven.

Amendment of s. 31a of the principal Act— Extension of period of payment of motor taxes into revenue.

- motor taxes into revenue.

 Amendment of s. 35 of the principal Act—Abolition of certain contributions by councils.
- 4. Section 31a of the principal Act is amended by striking out the word "thirty-seven" in the fifth line thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the word "thirty-eight".
 - 5. (1) Section 35 of the principal Act is amended as follows:—
 - (a) Paragraphs (c) and (d) of subsection (1) thereof are repealed:
 - (b) Paragraph ii. of the proviso to subsection (1) is repealed, and the following paragraph substituted therefor:—
 - (ii.) nothing in this subsection shall affect the liability of any council to pay to the Commissioner the cost of any work carried out

by the Commissioner (whether before or after the enactment of this proviso), at the request of the council under subsection (3a) of section 26 of this Act:

- (c) Subsections (3) and (4) of section 35 are repealed.
- 6. Section 36 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the words and letters "subdivisions (b), (c), and (d)" in the first and second lines thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the word and letter "subdivision (b)".
