An Act to amend the Hospitals Act, 1934-1959.

[Assented to 9th November, 1961.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Hospitals Act Amendment Act, 1961".

(2) The Hospitals Act, 1934-1959, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Hospitals Act, 1934-1961".

(3) The Hospitals Act, 1934-1959, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Incorporation.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

Amendment of

3. Subsection (2) of section 48 of the principal Act is amended by inserting at the end thereof the words "and as if the words 'board or committee of management of the hospital may from time to time fix in respect of the hospital' were substituted for the words 'the Governor may from time to time on the recommendation of the board or committee of management of the hospital by regulations which he is hereby empowered to make fix in respect of any public hospital'. Provided that any rate of payment or special rate fixed in respect of the hospital shall be reasonable."

4. The amendment effected by section 3 of this Act shall be deemed to have taken effect as from the passing of the Hospitals Act Amendment Act, 1959. <sup>Operation.</sup>
