An Act to amend the Holidays Act, 1910-1959.

[Assented to 10th December, 1970.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Holidays Act Amendment Short titles. Act, 1970".
- (2) The Holidays Act, 1910-1959, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Holidays Act, 1910-1970".
- (3) The Holidays Act, 1910-1959, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".
 - 2. The second schedule to the principal Act is amended—
- second schedule of principal Act.
- (a) by striking out from Part I the item "Christmas Day";
- (b) by inserting in Part I immediately after the item "Easter Monday" the item "The third Monday in May"; and
- (c) by inserting in Part II immediately after the item "The first day of January" the item "Christmas Day".

In the name and on behalf of Her Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
