An Act to amend the Housing Improvement Act, 1940-1950.

[Assented to 27th November, 1958.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles,

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Housing Improvement Act Amendment Act, 1958".

(2) The Housing Improvement Act, 1940-1950, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Housing Improvement Act, 1940-1958".

(3) The Housing Improvement Act, 1940-1950, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 16— General powers of housing authority. 2. Section 16 of the principal Act is amended by adding at the end thereof the following subsection :---

(4) With the consent of the Governor, the housing authority may erect on any land of the housing authority any shop, workshop, factory, hall or building of any kind which in the opinion of the housing authority will beneficially provide for the requirements of persons inhabiting houses erected by the housing authority. The housing authority may, for such term and upon such conditions as it thinks fit, let any such shop, workshop, factory, hall or building together with any land occupied therewith or may sell the same upon such conditions as the housing authority thinks fit. **3.** Section 43 of the principal Act is amended by striking out amendment of paragraph (c) of subsection (1) thereof.
