An Act to validate certain Advances made by the Government of the State for the relief of certain Settlers on Crown Lands.

[Assented to, October 8th, 1925.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. This Act may be cited as the "Hailstorm Relief (Validation) Act, 1925". Short title.

2. Where before the commencement of this Act, the Commissioner of Crown Lands or any person on behalf of the State has— Validation of certain advances.

(a) advanced any sum of money to any settler on Crown lands whose crop was in the month of November, nineteen hundred and twenty-four, damaged or destroyed by storm or hail ; or

(b) supplied or caused to be supplied to any such settler any commodities at the public expense,

the action of the said Commissioner or person in advancing any such sum of money or supplying or causing to be supplied any such commodities shall be as valid for all purposes as if the said action at the time of the taking thereof had been authorised by law.

3. Any contract or agreement made by or with the said Commissioner of Crown Lands and any bill of sale or other instrument executed in favour of the said Commissioner in connection with any such advance or supply of commodities as aforesaid shall be valid and effectual for all purposes. Validation of contracts.

In the name and on behalf of His Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
