An Act to amend the Impounding Act, 1920-1962.

[Assented to 24th February, 1966.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Impounding Act Amendment Act, 1965-1966". Short titles.

(2) The Impounding Act, 1920-1962, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Impounding Act, 1920-1966".

(3) The Impounding Act, 1920-1962, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.

3. Section 15a of the principal Act is amended by inserting at the end thereof the following subsection (the preceding portion of the section being designated as subsection (1) thereof):— Amendment of principal Act, s. 15a.

(2) Where any such cattle are conveyed by any vehicle to a pound or place to be impounded the ranger or person so conveying them or causing them so to be conveyed may claim the cost of such conveyance and such cost may be recovered in the same manner as a pound-keeper's fees and charges.
