An Act to amend the Industrial Arbitration Act Further Amendment Act, 1916.

[Assented to, November 16th, 1916.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and contact of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as the "Industrial Arbitration Act Short title. Amendment (President's Salary) Act, 1916."
- 2. (1) Subsection (1) of section 4 of the Industrial Arbitration Act Amendment of Act Further Amendment Act, 1916, is amended so as to read as 1243, 1916, s. 4follows:—
 - (1) The President shall receive a salary of One Thousand Salary of President. Seven Hundred Pounds per annum.
- (2) The amendment hereby made shall come into operation on the first day of July, nineteen hundred and seventeen.

In the name and on behalf of His Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
