An Act to amend the Industrial Code, 1920-1951.

[Assented to 22nd November, 1951.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Industrial Code Amendment Act (No. 3), 1951". Short titles.

(2) The Industrial Code, 1920-1951, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Industrial Code, 1920-1951".

(3) The Industrial Code, 1920-1951, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. Section 167 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the word "fifteen" in the ninth line of paragraph (a) and inserting in lieu thereof the word "twenty". Amendment of s. 167 of principal Act— Powers of industrial boards.
