**An Act to amend the Industrial Commission Jurisdiction
(Temporary Provisions) Act, 1975-1976.**

[Assented to 15th December, 1977]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Industrial Commission Jurisdiction (Temporary Provisions) Act Amendment Act, 1977".

(2) The Industrial Commission Jurisdiction (Temporary Provisions) Act, 1975-1976, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Industrial Commission Jurisdiction (Temporary Provisions) Act, 1975-1977".

2. Section 9 of the principal Act is repealed and the following section is enacted and inserted in its place:—

**Expiry
of Act.**

9. This Act shall expire on a day to be fixed by proclamation.
