An Act to amend the Industrial Commission Jurisdiction (Temporary Provisions) Act, 1975.

[Assented to 28th October, 1976]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Industrial Commission Jurisdiction short titles. (Temporary Provisions) Act Amendment Act, 1976".

(2) The Industrial Commission Jurisdiction (Temporary Provisions) Act, 1975, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Industrial Commission Jurisdiction (Temporary Provisions) Act, 1975-1976".

2. Section 9 of the principal Act is repealed and the following section is Repeal of s. 9 of principal Act is place:—

s. 9 of principal Act and enactment of section in its place----Expiry of Act.

9. (1) Subject to subsection (2) of this section, this Act shall expire $\mathop{}_{\text{Expiry of Act.}}^{\text{in its place-}}$ on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

(2) If a proclamation referred to in subsection (1) of this section has not been made before the thirty-first day of December, 1977, this Act shall expire on that day.
