An Act¹ to amend the Industries Development Act, 1941-1971.

[Assented to 21st October, 1971]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Industries Development Act Amendment Act (No. 2), 1971".

(2) The Industries Development Act, 1941-1971, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Industries Development Act, 1941-1971".

(3) The Industries Development Act, 1941-1971, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. Section 10 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after the present contents thereof (which are hereby designated subsection (1) thereof) the following subsection:—

(2) The functions of the committee shall include the investigation of any matters referred to it under or pursuant to any Act and the making of such reports and recommendations thereon as the committee thinks fit.

3. Section 25 of the principal Act and the heading immediately preceding that section are repealed.
