An Act to amend the Industries Development Act, 1941-1949.

[Assented to 6th December, 1951.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the “ Industries Develop- Short titles.
ment Act Amendment Act, 1951 ”.

(2) The Industries Development Act, 1941-1949, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the “ Industries Development Act, 1941-1951 ”.

(3) The Industries Development Act, 1941-1949, is hereinafter referred to as “ the principal Act ”.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Incorporation.
Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

3. The following section is enacted and inserted in the Enactment of

principal Act—
principal Act after section 16a thereof :—

16aa. (1) From the money standing to the credit of the Transfer of
certain money
to Country
Secondary
Industries
Fund.
Loan Fund Account there shall be transferred to the Country Secondary Industries Fund the sum of twenty-five thousand pounds.

(2) The sum so transferred may be applied by the Treasurer towards making a loan to the Company known as S.A. Refractories Limited in accordance with the recommendations of the Committee.

(3) This Act, without further appropriation, shall be sufficient authority for the transfer and application of money in accordance with the preceding subsections of this section.
