An Act to amend the Industries Development Act,  
 1941-1947.

[Assented to 1st December, 1949.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South  
 Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament  
 thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Industries Development Act Amendment Act, 1949". Short titles.

(2) The Industries Development Act, 1941-1947, as amended  
 by this Act, may be cited as the "Industries Development Act,  
 1941-1949".

(3) The Industries Development Act, 1941-1947, is hereinafter  
 referred to as "the principal Act".

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Incorporation.  
 Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

3. Section 19a of the principal Act is amended —

(a) by striking out the word "fifty" in the third line of  
 subsection (4) and inserting in lieu thereof the  
 words "one hundred";

(b) by striking out the word "forty-nine" at the end  
 thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the word  
 "fifty-two".
