# GEORGII V REGIS.

An Act to Validate the Issue, pursuant to the Redemption of Public Securities Act, 1923, of Certain Registered Stock, and for other purposes.

*[Assented to, September 11th, 1924.]*

**B**E it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the "Issue of Registered Stock (Validation) Act, 1924." Short title.
2. This Act is incorporated with the Redemption of Public Securities Act, 1923, and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation. No. 1587 of 1923.
3. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 4 of the Redemption of Public Securities Act, 1923, the issue, pursuant to the said Act, in London on or about the thirty-first day of March, nineteen hundred and twenty-four, of Registered Stock to the value of One Million Six Hundred and Fifty Thousand Three Hundred Pounds shall be and be deemed to have been lawfully made, and the times for repayment of the principal moneys due and repayable in respect of the said Registered Stock shall be those set out in the stock certificates issued in respect of the said Registered Stock and shall not be affected by any provision of the said section. Validation of issue of certain Registered Stock.
