An Act to amend the Industrial Safety, Health and Welfare Act, 1972-1981.

[Assented to 16 June 1983]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Industrial Safety, Health and Welfare Act Amendment Act, 1983".

(2) The Industrial Safety, Health and Welfare Act, 1972-1981, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Industrial Safety, Health and Welfare Act, 1972-1983".

Amendment of schedule.

2. The schedule to the principal Act is amended by inserting after item 43 the following item:

44. The removal of asbestos from buildings and the grant (conditional or unconditional), suspension and cancellation by the Permanent Head of licences to carry out such work.
