An Act to Repeal an Act No. 186 of 1880.

[Assented to, November 17th, 1886.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to repeal Act No. 186 of 1880—Be Preamble. it therefore Enacted by the Governor of the Province of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly of the said province, in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:

1. The Act No. 186 of 1880, "An Act to provide for the payment of retiring allowances to Judges of the Supreme Court in certain cases, and for other purposes," is hereby repealed: Provided that such repeal shall not affect the pension of any of the present Judges.

In the name and on behalf of Her Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
