## No. 16.

An Act to amend an Act No. 9 of 1854, intituled "An Act to Organize and Establish a Militia Force in South Australia.'

[Assented to, 1st September, 1859.]

THEREAS it is expedient to amend an Act, No. 9, of 1854, "To Preamble. Organize and Establish a Militia Force in South Australia, in the particulars hereinafter mentioned—Be it therefore Enacted by the Governor-in-Chief of the Province of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly of the said Province, in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:

1. Instead of the rates of pay fixed by the said Act, the officers, Alteration of rates of non-commissioned officers, and privates of the Militia, by the said pay-Act authorized to be called out and embodied, shall be entitled to the rates of pay hereinafter mentioned, when embodied for actual service, or when called out and assembled for training and exercise, as by the said Act provided.

Short title of Act.

3. This Act may be cited as "The Militia Act Amendment Act."

Commencement of Act.
