An Act to amend "The Marriage Act, 1867."

[Assented to, 30th January, 1869.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Marriage Act, 1867"—Be it therefore Enacted by the Governor of the Province of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly of the said Province, in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:

1. Section 38 of "The Marriage Act, 1867," is hereby repealed. Repeal of Section 38.

2. Act No. 7 of 1864, intituled "An Act to amend the Acts relating to Marriages in the Province of South Australia, by extending certain provisions thereof to persons professing with the Society of Friends, called Quakers," is hereby repealed, except so far as may be necessary to support any act heretofore lawfully done under the authority thereof. Repeal of Act No. 7 of 1864.

In the name and on behalf of the Queen I hereby assent to this Act.
