An Act to amend the Mining Act 1971.

[Assented to 27 October 1994]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Short title

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Mining (Royalties) Amendment Act 1994.

(2) The Mining Act 1971 is referred to in this Act as "the principal Act".

Commencement

2. This Act will come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

Amendment of s. 17—Royalty

3. Section 17 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from subsection (2) "or, in the case of extractive minerals, 5 per cent,".

Amendment of s. 63-Extractive Areas Rehabilitation Fund

4. Section 63 of the principal Act is amended by inserting in subsection (2) "50 percent of" after "The Minister shall pay into the fund".
