An Act to amend the Margarine Act, 1939-1973.

[Assented to 5th December, 1974]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Margarine Act Amendment Act, 1974". Short titles.

(2) The Margarine Act, 1939-1973, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Margarine Act, 1939-1974".

2. (1) This Act, other than section 6 thereof, shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation. Commencement.

(2) Section 6 of this Act shall come into operation on the first day of January, 1976.

3. Section 3 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by inserting after the definition of "butter fat" in subsection (1) the following definition:—

"dairy blend" means dairy blend as defined for the purposes of the Dairy Industry Act, 1928-1974;;

and

(b) by inserting in the definition of "margarine" in subsection (1) after paragraph (c) thereof the passage "but does not include dairy blend".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 3—
Interpretation.

4. Section 16 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the passage "one hundred" and inserting in lieu thereof the figures "90".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 16—
No licence for premises near butter factories.

Amendment of principal Act, s. 20—
Control of the amount of table margarine that may be manufactured.

5. Section 20 of the principal Act is amended by striking out subsection (8) and inserting in lieu thereof the following subsection:—

(8) The Minister shall not, by any notice made under this section—

(a) expressed to have effect in relation to the year ending on the thirty-first day of December, 1974, permit to be manufactured in that year a greater quantity of table margarine than seven hundred and twelve tonnes;

and

(b) expressed to have effect in relation to the year ending on the thirty-first day of December, 1975, permit to be manufactured in that year a greater quantity of table margarine than one thousand seven hundred and fifty-three tonnes.

Repeal of ss. 20, 20a, 21, 23 and 24 of principal Act.

6. Sections 20, 20a, 21, 23 and 24 of the principal Act are repealed.
