An Act to amend the Margarine Act, 1939-1948.

[Assented to 27th November, 1952.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Margarine Act Amendment Act, 1952". Short title.

(2) The Margarine Act, 1939-1948, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Margarine Act, 1939-1952".

(3) The Margarine Act, 1939-1948, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. Section 20 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out the words "three hundred and twelve" in the last line of subsection (3) thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "four hundred and sixty-eight";

(b) by inserting therein after subsection (3a) thereof the following subsection :—

(3b) The Minister may by notice in the *Government Gazette* vary the declaration made under this section on the twenty-fifth day of October, nineteen hundred and fifty-one and published in the

Government Gazette on the first day of November, nineteen hundred and fifty-one at page 1052.

The notice so varied may permit to be manufactured during the year to which the said notice relates an aggregate quantity of table margarine not exceeding four hundred and sixty-eight tons.
