An Act to amend the Marine Act, 1936-1968

[Assented to 17th December, 1970]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Marine Act Amendment Short titles. Act, 1970".
- (2) The Marine Act, 1936-1968, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Marine Act, 1936-1970".
- (3) The Marine Act, 1936-1968, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".
- 2. (1) This Act shall not come into operation until Her Majesty's Suspending provision. pleasure therein has been publicly signified in this State.
- (2) Subject to subsection (1) of this section, this Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.
- 3. Section 4 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after Amendment of principal Act, the item-

4. Section 5 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the definition of "vessel" and inserting in lieu thereof the following definition:—

"vessel" means any kind of ship, boat or vessel used in navigation and includes—

(a) a hovercraft or other air cushion vehicle;

or

(b) any other vehicle supported or propelled by pneumatic force,

that traverses any navigable waters within or adjacent to the State:

Amendment of principal Act, s. 26—

Cancellation or suspension of certificates of competency. 5. Section 26 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from subsection (5) the word "it" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "he".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 51—

Appointment of officers, etc.

6. Section 51 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the word "its" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "his".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 62—

Breach of regulations or rules to imply wilful default of person in charge. 7. Section 62 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after the word "regulation" the passage "or rule".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 67g—
Fishing vessels.

- 8. Section 67g of the principal Act is amended—
 - (a) by inserting after paragraph (c) of subsection (1) the following paragraph:—
 - (ca) requiring any person who proposes to build a fishing vessel that will when built be subject to the requirements of this Act relating to survey, to submit plans, drawings and specifications of the fishing vessel to the Director of Marine and Harbors for approval and restricting or prohibiting the building of fishing vessels otherwise than in conformity with plans, drawings and specifications approved by the Director of Marine and Harbors;;

and

(b) by striking out from paragraph (i) of subsection (1) the passage "two hundred dollars" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "five hundred dollars".

9. Section 69 of the principal Act is amended by striking out Amendment of paragraph I of subsection (1) and inserting in lieu thereof the s. 69 following paragraph:-

- 1. Every ship that is used for the conveyance of passengers for hire or reward or any other direct or indirect consideration:.
- 10. Section 81 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the Amendment of passage "one month from the day upon which the certificate of s. 81 survey expires upon payment of a fee of four dollars and twenty Power of Minister to cents" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "three months from extend certificate. the day on which the certificate of survey expires on payment of the prescribed fee".
