An Act to amend the Metropolitan and Export Abattoirs Act, 1936-1955.

[Assented to 8th November, 1956.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Metropolitan and Export Abattoirs Act Amendment Act, 1956".

(2) The Metropolitan and Export Abattoirs Act, 1936-1955, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Metropolitan and Export Abattoirs Act, 1936-1956".

(3) The Metropolitan and Export Abattoirs Act, 1936-1955 is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Incorporation.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

Commencement of Act.

3. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by the Governor by proclamation.

4. Subsection (1) of section 7 of the principal Act is amended—

Amendment of s. 7 of principal Act—
The Metropolitan Abattoirs Area.

(a) by striking out the word "and" in the fourth line of paragraph (a) and inserting after the word "Prospect" in that line the words "Payneham, Walkerville, West Torrens, Mitcham, Campbelltown and Enfield"; and

- (b) by striking out paragraphs (b) and (c) thereof; and
- (c) by striking out paragraph (d) thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the following paragraph:—
- (d) The district of Salisbury; and
- (d) by striking out the word "district" in the first, third, and last lines of paragraph (f) and inserting in lieu thereof in each case the word "municipality".
