An Act to provide for the reduction for a further period of seven calendar months of certain Ministerial and Parliamentary salaries.

[Assented to, 31st October, 1935.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the "Ministerial and Parliamentary Salaries Act, 1935". Short title.

2. This Act is incorporated with Part IV. of the Financial Emergency Act, 1931, and that Part and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.

3. The reduction in Ministerial and Parliamentary salaries and allowances made by sections 10, 11, and 12 of the Financial Emergency Act, 1931, shall remain in operation for a further period of seven calendar months commencing from the first day of December, nineteen hundred and thirty-five. Reduction of certain salaries for further period.
