An Act to repeal the Market Clauses Act, 1870, the East-End Market Act, 1872, and the Adelaide Fruit and Produce Exchange Act, 1903.

[Assented to 9 March 1989]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the *Market Acts Repeal Act, 1989*.

Repeals

2. The following Acts are repealed:
 - (a) the Market Clauses Act, 1870;
 - (b) the East-End Market Act, 1872;
 - (c) the Adelaide Fruit and Produce Exchange Act, 1903.
