An Act to enable the Mayor of the Corporation of the Town of Kapunda to expend the Moneys standing to the Credit of the Fund commonly known as the "Mayor's Bounty Fund" for the Relief of Unemployment, and for purposes incidental thereto.

[Assented to, November 12th, 1930.]

WHEREAS in the year eighteen hundred and sixty-seven and Preamble.
in subsequent years the Honorable James Pearce a member of the Legislative Council and Mayor of the Town of Kapunda set apart certain moneys to form a trust fund since commonly known as the "Mayor's Bounty Fund" and declared that the said fund should be used "for the relief of the distressed arising from any extraordinary general calamity within the corporate bounds of Kapunda" and that the custody and disbursement of the said fund should be by the person holding the office of Mayor of Kapunda for the time being: And whereas the said James Pearce and other persons have since the year eighteen hundred and sixty-seven paid divers sums of money into the said fund which now exceeds the sum of Five Hundred Pounds: And whereas no extraordinary general calamity within the boundaries of the Town of Kapunda has occurred since the institution of the fund and it is desirable that the moneys standing to the credit of the said fund should be used for the purpose of assisting and relieving residents of Kapunda who are in necessitous circumstances owing to unemployment:— Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the "Mayor's Bounty Fund (Kapunda) Short title.

2. The person for the time being holding the office of Mayor of the Corporation of the Town of Kapunda may expend any moneys whether principal or interest for the time being vested in him as trustee of the said Mayor's Bounty Fund for the purpose of affording assistance and relief in such manner and on such terms and conditions as the said Mayor thinks fit to any residents of the Town of Kapunda who in his opinion are in necessitous circumstances owing to unemployment, or for the purpose of providing any work which the said Mayor thinks proper, in which such persons may be employed.
