An Act to amend the Meat Hygiene Act, 1980.

[Assented to 5 March 1987]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Meat Hygiene Act Amendment short title. Act, 1987".
- (2) The Meat Hygiene Act, 1980, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".
- 2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by procla- Commencement. mation.
 - 3. Section 6 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out from subsection (1) "three members" and substituting "four members";

and

- (b) by inserting after paragraph (b) of subsection (1) the following paragraph:
 - (ba) one shall be a person appointed by the Minister upon the nomination of the Minister of the Commonwealth for the time being responsible for the administration of the Meat Inspection Act 1983 of the Commonwealth;.
- 4. Section 9 of the principal Act is amended by striking out "Two" from subsection (1) and substituting "Three".

Amendment of Quorum, etc.

5. Section 50 of the principal Act is amended by striking out "an Amendment of Inspector" and substituting "an Inspector or a Commonwealth Inspector".

6. Section 51 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from Amendment of subsection (1) "unless he is an Inspector or is acting at the direction of an offences relating Inspector" and substituting "unless the person is, or is acting on the direction to branding of meat. of, an Inspector or a Commonwealth Inspector".

Amendment of s. 52— Prohibition on sale of meat produced at unlicensed works 7. Section 52 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after "an Inspector" in paragraph (a) of subsection (1) "or a Commonwealth Inspector".

Amendment of s. 55— Prohibition on sale of pet food produced at unlicensed abattoir or pet food works. 8. Section 55 of the principal Act is amended by inserting "abattoir or" after "licensed".

Amendment of s. 60— Evidence. 9. Section 60 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after "licensed" in subparagraph (x) of paragraph (a) "abattoir or".
