## No. 118 of 1983

An Act to amend the Marketing of Eggs Act, 1941, and to make a consequential amendment to the Egg Industry Stablization Act, 1973.

[Assented to 22 December 1983]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Marketing of Eggs Act Amendment Short title. Act, 1983".
- (2) The Marketing of Eggs Act, 1941, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".
- 2. Section 4 of the principal Act is amended by striking out subsection (2) and substituting the following subsection:

Amendment of s. 4— Constitution of

- (2) The board shall consist of seven members of whom-
  - (a) three shall be elected in accordance with section 4a; and
  - (b) four shall be persons appointed by the Governor.
- 3. The Egg Industry Stabilization Act, 1973, is amended—

Amendment of Egg Industry Stablization Act,

- (a) in section 6 by striking out from subsection (2) the word "three";
- (b) in section 7 by striking out from subsection (4) the word "Two" and substituting the word "Three".
