An Act to amend The Marine Stores Act, 1898-1947.

[Assented to 23rd October, 1958.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Marine Stores Act Amendment Act, 1958". Short titles.

(2) The Marine Stores Act, 1898-1947, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Marine Stores Act, 1898-1958".

(3) The Marine Stores Act, 1898-1947, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. Section 10 of the principal Act is amended—

- (a) by inserting after the word "Police" in the fifth line thereof the words "and to the municipal council or the district council in the municipality or district of which his business is intended to be carried on," ;
- (b) by inserting after the word "him" in the ninth line thereof the words "or such municipal council or district council" ;
- (c) by striking out the words "one pound" in the penultimate line thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "three pounds three shillings".
