An Act to Reduce the Salaries of Ministers of the Crown by Fifteen per Centum for a period of One Year.

[Assented to, November 20th, 1930.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. This Act may be cited as the "Ministers' Salaries Reduction Act, 1930". Short title.
2. This Act is incorporated with the Constitution Amendment Act, 1908, and all Acts incorporated therewith. Incorporation.
3. For a period of twelve calendar months commencing on the first day of the month after the month in which this Act is assented to, the annual amount of money available for the salaries of Ministers of the Crown pursuant to the Constitution Amendment (Ministers Salaries) Act, 1921, shall be reduced by Fifteen per centum. Reduction of Ministers' salaries.

In the name and on behalf of His Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
