No. 38 of 1957.**An Act to amend the Metropolitan Transport Advisory Council Act, 1954.**

[Assented to 14th November, 1957.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Metropolitan Transport Advisory Council Act Amendment Act, 1957".

(2) The Metropolitan Transport Advisory Council Act, 1954, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Metropolitan Transport Advisory Council Act, 1954-1957".

(3) The Metropolitan Transport Advisory Council Act, 1954, is hereinafter called "the principal Act".

Incorporation.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

**Amendment of s. 5 of principal Act—
Term of office.**

3. Section 5 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the word "fifty-seven" in the third line and inserting in lieu thereof the word "fifty-nine".

4. Section 14 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the word "fifty-seven" in the second line of subsection (5) and inserting in lieu thereof the word "fifty-nine".
