An Act to amend the Metropolitan Transport Advisory Council Act, 1954-1957.

[Assented to 19th May, 1960.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Metropolitan Transport Advisory Council Act Amendment Act, 1960". Short titles.

(2) The Metropolitan Transport Advisory Council Act, 1954-1957, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Metropolitan Transport Advisory Council Act, 1954-1960".

(3) The Metropolitan Transport Advisory Council Act, 1954-1957, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.

3. Section 5 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the word "fifty-nine" therein and inserting in lieu thereof the word "sixty-two". Amendment of s. 5 of principal Act—Term of office.

4. Subsection (5) of section 14 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the word "fifty-nine" therein and inserting in lieu thereof the word "sixty-two". Amendment of s. 14 of principal Act—Directions concerning railways and tramways.

Commencement.

5. This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the thirtieth day of December, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-nine.
