An Act to amend the Motor Vehicles Act, 1959.

[Assented to 26 November 1987]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Short title.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Motor Vehicles Act Amendment Act (No. 3), 1987".

(2) The Motor Vehicles Act, 1959, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

Amendment of s. 24—
Duty to grant registration.

2. Section 24 of the principal Act is amended by striking out subsection (5) and substituting the following subsection:

(5) The Registrar may refuse to register a motor vehicle—

(a) if satisfied that the motor vehicle does not comply with an Act or regulation that regulates the design, construction or maintenance of such a motor vehicle;

or

(b) if satisfied that the motor vehicle would, if driven on a road, put the safety of persons using the road at risk.
