### No. 1928.

An Act to vest certain Land in the Corporation of the City of Adelaide.

[Assented to, December 12th, 1929.]

**B**E it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the "North Terrace (Alignment) Act, Short title. 1929".

2. The land shown on the plan annexed to this Act and therein stippled in black is hereby vested in the Corporation of the City of Adelaide for an estate in fee simple and shall form part of the public street known as North Terrace.

Vesting of certain land in the Corporation of the City of Adelaide.

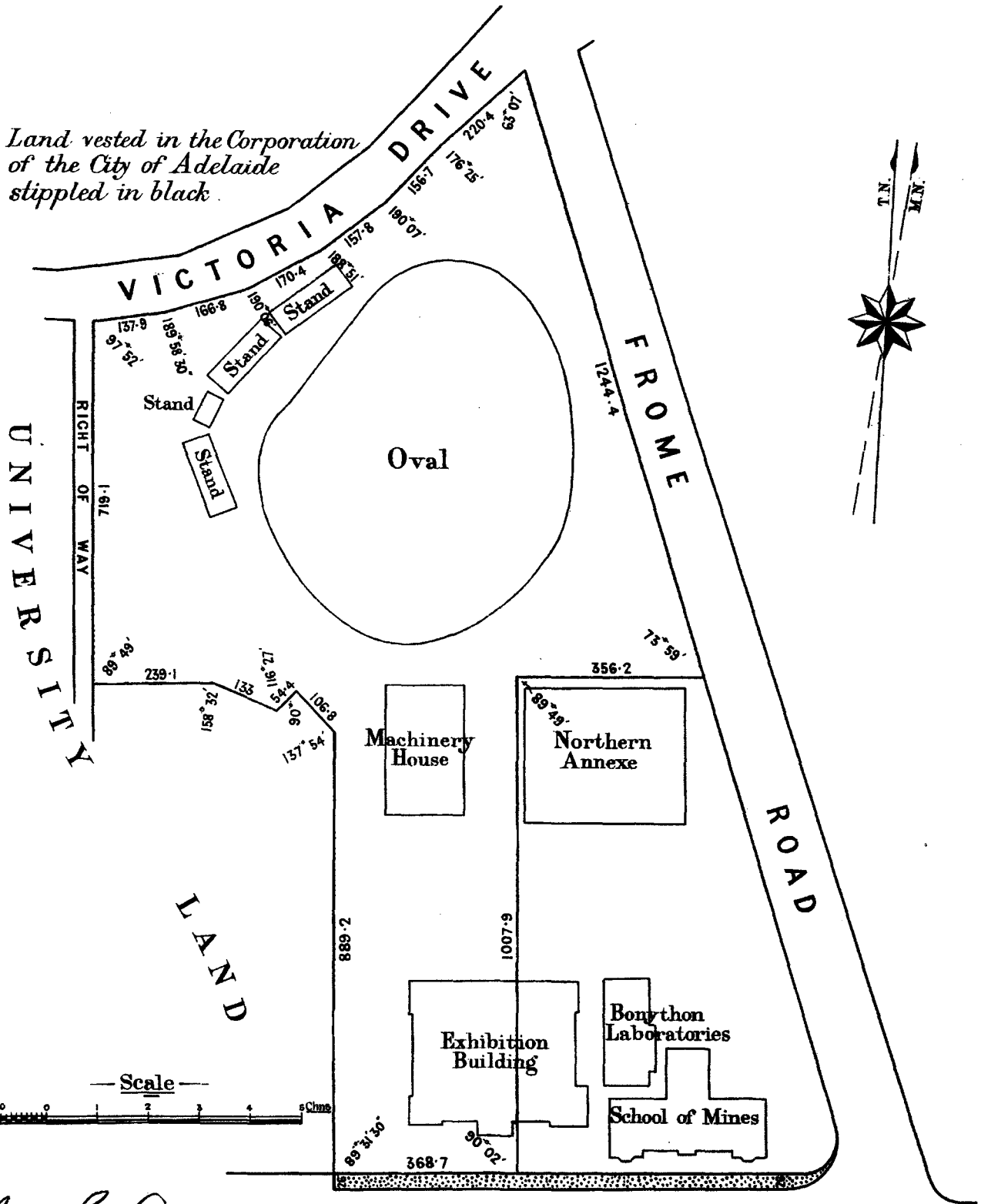
