GEORGII V REGIS. A.D. 1926.

An Act to Vest a portion of the Adelaide Park Lands in the South Australian Railways Commissioner, to Define the Alignment of a certain portion of North Terrace in the City of Adelaide, and for other purposes.

[Assented to, November 4th, 1926.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as the "North Terrace and Railway Short title. Lands Act, 1926."
- 2. Except where otherwise provided, the provisions of this Act commencement shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.
- 3. The piece of land delineated in the plan in the First Schedule Vesting of certain hereto and therein hachured black, being portion of the Adelaide Park lands in South Australian Railways Park Lands, shall from the day on which this Act receives the Commissioner. Royal Assent, cease to be park lands, and shall from the time aforesaid vest in the South Australian Railways Commissioner in his corporate capacity for an estate of inheritance in fee simple.

4. (1) The piece of land delineated in the plan in the Second Fixing of alignment Schedule hereto and therein stippled in black is hereby declared to of North Terrace. be a public street and to be vested for an estate of fee simple in, and to be under the care, control, and management of the Corporation of the City of Adelaide. 


